



Service Area: Socio-Economic Impact Assessment
Project: SEIA for 1,000 MW Shepard Gas Fired Power Plant

Location: Calgary, Alberta

Enmax Power is proposing to build the 1,000 MW Shepard gas fired power plant on the eastern edge of the City of Calgary. The **Human Environment Group (HEG)** was engaged to conduct Social-Economic Impact Assessments as part of the larger regulatory process.

The SEIA was a high level assessment of potential impacts focused mostly on the effects from the construction phase, including potential effects of a large construction workforce in the Shepard Industrial area.

The SEIA also included a number mitigation options to help reduce the effect of the Project on service and infrastructure. The Project received regulatory approval from the Alberta Utilities Commission and provincial government and is schedule to begin construction in 2011.
