The **human environment group (HEG)** conducted a social situational analysis and due diligences for the Tyler Resources' Bahuerachi Copper Development. The mining concession is located in communal land (ejido) in the Mexican northern state of Chihuahua.

The objective of the project was to assess social and environmental performance of Tyler's operations and present recommendations for strengthening environmental compliance with international standards and improving the relationship with local population as well as local and regional authorities.

Through document review and extensive field work which included site assessment, interviews, focus groups and participation in local assemblies with a series of stakeholders including indigenous and non-indigenous population and municipal authorities, **HEG** assess the status of the social license to operate as well as compliance with Mexican regulations and international standards.
